From Saturday 28 September to Sunday 6 October we are planning a **Novena of Celebration** with a week of reflection on how blessed we are as members of the parish.

At the 10:00 am Mass, Mon to Fri, we will reflect on sources of that blessing and thank God for His goodness to us.

- On Monday 30 Sept - Feast of St. Jerome - Mass is offered for the people of our Parish. We thank God for all who work in St Munchin's Maternity Hospital.
- On Tuesday 1 Oct - Feast of St. Thérèse – we thank God for the gift that schools have been for us. Pupils of Ard Scoil Rís and Villiers, will be present.
- On Wednesday 2 Oct – Feast of the Guardian Angel – we give thanks for the sacraments we received while at school. Pupils of the Salesians and JFK, will be present.
- On Thursday 3 Oct – Feast of Blessed Columba Marmion - we celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation after Mass.
- On Friday 4 Oct - Feast of St Francis of Assisi - we celebrate the Sacrament of the Sick. All are invited to receive the Sacrament.

At the 6:00 pm Vigil Mass on Saturday, Feast of St. Faustina Kowalska, we thank God for the Sacrament of Marriage and for all families in our parish.
