

EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

LENT begins this week on Ash Wednesday. Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the Season of Lent. It is a day of fast and abstinence. Lent is a season of penance, reflection and fasting which prepares us for Christ's Resurrection on Easter Sunday.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS led by Br. Jim Dormer, will be held each Friday during lent after 10 am Mass.

The beginning of Lent depends on the date of Easter. Easter follows a lunar calendar and is celebrated on the Sunday that follows the first full moon after 21 March (the Spring equinox). Therefore, Easter cannot fall earlier than 22 March or later than 25 April.
